

Title The Opinions of Child Attendants towards the Problems of Education Management of Child Development Centers in Sub-District Administration Organization, Maha Sarakham

The purpose of this research was to analyze and compare the opinions of the Child Attendants towards the problems of education management of child development centers in sub-district administration organization, Maha Sarakham regarding educational background and teaching experience. The sample subjects were three hundred participants selected by the stratified random sampling technique with Krejcie and Morgan table. The data were collected by a rating scale questionnaire with .97 of the reliability value. The research statistics used were mean, standard deviation, t-test (independent) and One-Way ANOVA.

Results of the research were as follows:

According to the data, it was found that the average opinion of the Child Attendants towards the problems of education management was moderate. They were a personal management, academic affairs and academic activities, environmental and classroom management, teaching materials and learning source, assessment of children development, supervision, academic seminar, and community-based participation.

The average opinion of the Child Attendants towards the problems of education management regarding the educational background was not significantly different at the .05 level. They were teaching materials and learning source, and community-based participation. Whereas, the opinions of the Child Attendants towards a personal management, academic affairs and academic activities, environmental and classroom management, assessment of children development, supervision, academic seminar were significantly different at the .05 level.
